Waste Management Project in Culik, Karangasem

Culik is a small village located in Kecamatan Abang, Karangasem. The village is close to the tourist area of Amed. Currently Culik suffers from rubbish problem. We could easily found the rubbish threw indiscriminately everywhere. The village has no facility to transport the waste nor a plant to process it. The common practice is people throw garbage into the garden, or into a dead river that crosses the village.

The result is the waste of the village mostly organic (more than 80%), followed by plastic around 7-8%. This data will be used as a basis to design the waste facility.

Funded by the Ministry of Public Works, GUS facilitates to implement waste management facilities for the village. The main consideration for selecting Culik because the initiative comes from the community. Socialization of the project was conducted on May 4, 2012. Followed by sampling the household waste, conducted in late May.

The meeting was held on May 7 joined by the warung owners in Suluban to inform the progress of the project, which aims to manage solid and liquid waste generated by activities in this area so as not to pollute the surrounding environment, particularly the beach and the sea.
