HELLO!! At the end of 2011 GUS collaborated with other parties to work on various environmental programs.

BALI REBOISASI FESTIVAL 2011 organized by Yayasan Hijau Lestari Bali with NPO Asian Green Forest Network - Japan, in collaboration with the community, including the Bali Outbound Community, Siki Foundation, GUS and high school students. Hundreds of people planted Eucalyptus which located on the slopes of Mount Batur, Kintamani - Bali on Sunday, December 4, 2011.



BEACH CLEAN UP PROJECT SEGARA

GUS has supporting Segara Beach clean up activities in Kuta for many years. Billabong initiated a big clean up with participation of its staffs on December 9, 2011. About 50 people participants from Billabong and GUS clean up Segara Beach. On the same day, GUS and Billabong puts some bins at the beach. For a long term project, a composting facility will be placed on site to process the organic waste.





Following the former clean up, GUS keeps monitoring Segara beach regularly. GUS conducted another clean up on January 20, 2012 at the beach where all the organic and inorganic waste are still dumped indiscriminately. The program includes an approach to the warungs and the fishermen to later work together with them at the beach.



GUS also continues to work with other NGOs to conduct communication and consultation with the Government in this case with the Environment Agency (Badan Lingkungan Hidup Provinsi Bali) with an aim to encourage retailers' participation to reducing plastic waste in Bali.

Later in 2012 GUS continues to collaborate with Satker PU Provinsi Bali to conduct education programs.
