## Bank Sampah of Desa Culik, Karangasem



Bank Sampah is a 3-month pilot project for Desa Culik, Karangasem, with the participation of 15 KK (Head of Family). They collected all kinds of plastic waste which was bought by the Karangasem rency government for Rp. 1000, - / kg.

After the pilot phase, the project will proceed with more participants from the village. The long-term goals include more people to participate actively managing their own waste, to create cleaner environment, to reduce the volume of waste to be processed at the landfill and to generate additional revenue.



## Socialization of MCK Implementation in Alengkong, Bangli



This activity is carried out in Bale Banjar Alengkong to discuss the design and implementation of MCK (Mandi-Cuci-Kakus : Bathe-Wash-Latrine). The objective of the project is to provide adequate sanitation facilities for the people of Alengkong. As the homes are located far apart, there also a number of individual latrines planned.



## Bins and Composters for Schools

Bins and composters were handed to the winners of the school sanitation campaign conducted by Satker PPLP Bali and GUS. The schools were located in Denpasar, Karangasem and Bangli. As seen in the pictures were our visit to the SD 5 Peninjoan, Bangli. We also held a short course on how to use the composter to process the organic waste.



## Meeting with Warung Owners of Suluban



Related with Eco Surf Rescue Uluwatu, we maintain regular communication with the Warung owners and other business in the area of Suluban Beach. This time we discussed about installing lightings on side of the stairs and planting trees in the same location. We also discussed the possibility to sell used cooking oil from Warungs to Yayasan Caritas, rather than being discarded indiscriminately and polluting the environment.
