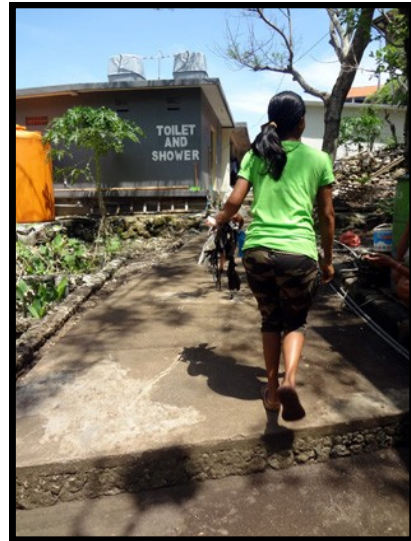


Suluban
